****Shipped Semen/Semen Pick-up****

- * Shipped semen is available via FedEx or UPS at a cost of \$100.00 per shipment.
- * You must call by 12:00 (noon) on the day you wish to have semen shipped.
- * Semen is available for pick-up at the University Horse Farm after 12:00 (noon).
- * The charge is \$30.00 per pick-up, if the mare owner provides his/her own container.
- * The charge is \$60.00 per pick-up, if the University provides a new box.



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Terms and Conditions: I, the undersigned, agree:

1. This contract relates to the mare specifically named and described above, which description the undersigned certifies to be true and complete. This contract is valid only to the mare and owner named and may not be amended or modified, except by a mutual exchange of written instruments, nor may this contract or any rights or obligations hereunder be assigned without the prior written consent of both parties.
2. **On Farm Breeding:** That the above-designated mare is free of all infection and is physically fit for breeding purposes and that such mare is not unmanageable or vicious. The University reserves the right to refuse any mare it deems unfit for breeding or any mares/mare and foal that, at their sole discretion, deem that the mare is unsafe for personnel on the farm.
3. That all mares **MUST** have a photocopy of a negative EIA (Coggins) test taken within 1 year.
4. That all mares shall have been vaccinated a minimum of 14 days prior to arrival at farm for: Tetanus, Influenza, Streptococcus Equi (Strangles), West Nile Virus (WNV), Rabies and Eastern & Western Encephalomyelitis (EEE & WEE), Rhinopneumonitis EVH-1 & EVH-4. Mares shall have been dewormed within 60 days.
5. Mare Owner authorizes the University, to engage performance of veterinary services, (such as palpation, ultrasound, pregnancy testing, suturing, etc.) as the Farm or its Veterinarians may deem reasonably necessary for the proper treatment, care and protection of the mare and/or foal at side. Mare Owner also acknowledges that the University will/may perform certain customary and ordinary procedures under guidance of veterinarian and/or that some reproductive procedures will/may be performed by Farm staff/technicians under supervision or at direction of Farm veterinarian. All veterinary procedures are to be done at the Mare Owner's expense and will be billed monthly.
6. Mare Owner shall be invoiced at the first of each month for all mare care charges including but not limited to veterinary services, farrier services, special dietary services as well as board expenses. Said invoices are to be paid in full and received by the Farm by the 20th of the month. Farm reserves the right to impose, after ten days from the date payment is due, to charge interest at the rate of 18% per annum on all unpaid sums.
7. The accrued board, veterinary expenses, mare care, farrier expenses, and other related charges shall become due and payable prior to pick up of Mare. Farm shall have a lien against the Mare, any Foal at side and the produce of the mating which is the subject of this Agreement until such time as any and all charges are paid in full; said lien shall survive any transfer of possession. Mare Owner agrees to pay all charges when due and should Mare Owner fail to do so, Farm is entitled to recover any costs, interest, expenses and attorney's fees expended in collection. In addition, the University reserves the right to withhold issuance of the Mating Certificate until Mare Owner is current on all payment obligations to the University.
8. That the stallion service fee is due and payable when the mare has a foal that can stand and nurse ("live foal"), or when the mare changes ownership, whichever occurs first. The University shall presume the birth of a live foal one calendar year after breeding unless owner proves that no live foal was born.
9. The University agrees to diligently try to settle Mare. If Mare does not settle, Mare Owner will hold the University harmless from any loss or damage. University shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, theft, death, or injury which may be suffered by the mare and/or foal, or any other cause of action whatsoever arising out of or connected in any way with the breeding or boarding of the mare and/or foal. Mare owner fully understands that all risks connected with the breeding and boarding of the Mare and/or foal are born by the Mare owner.
10. That this contract and the terms thereof shall be governed by the laws of the State of Illinois. **WARNING:** Under the Equine Activity Liability Act, each participant who engages in an equine activity expressly assumes the risks of engaging in and legal responsibility for injury, loss, or damage to person or property resulting from the risk of equine activities.
